

Autumn Term Part 2.

Anglo - Saxons

Our key subject for the topic is History.

Over the next half term we will be learning about Anglo - Saxons and where they came from.

In maths we will continue our learning of addition and subtraction and will start looking at multiplication and division. In our maths learning we follow White Rose Maths.

In English we will be looking at Non - Fiction texts related to our topic of Anglo - Saxons. We will look at instructions & explanations and move on to writing a diary entry.

History - Anglo Saxons

During this half term we will be looking at:

- Saxon timeline and world history timeline.
- Where they came from and how did they settle?
- Settlements and daily life.
- Sutton Hoo and other Saxon sites.
- Key figures of the Saxon period.

Science - Light



- Recognise that you need light in order to see things and that dark is the absence of light.
- Notice that light is reflected from surfaces.
- Recognise that light from the sun can be dangerous.
- Recognise that shadows are formed when the light from a source is blocked.
- Find patterns in the way that size of shadows change.

Art - Clay



- Create 3D models of real objects
- Design and create slab built structures
- Create different textures on a clay surface

- Know the key beliefs of Christianity
- Understand that the UK is a multicultural country.
- Know the when and why of Christian festivals and how Christmas is celebrated around the world.
- Know the Christmas story.

Computing - Networks & online safety



- Use search technology effectively and have a basic understanding of key words and search rankings.
- Know the potential dangers of online activities.
- Know how to behave appropriately online.

PE - Throwing and Catching



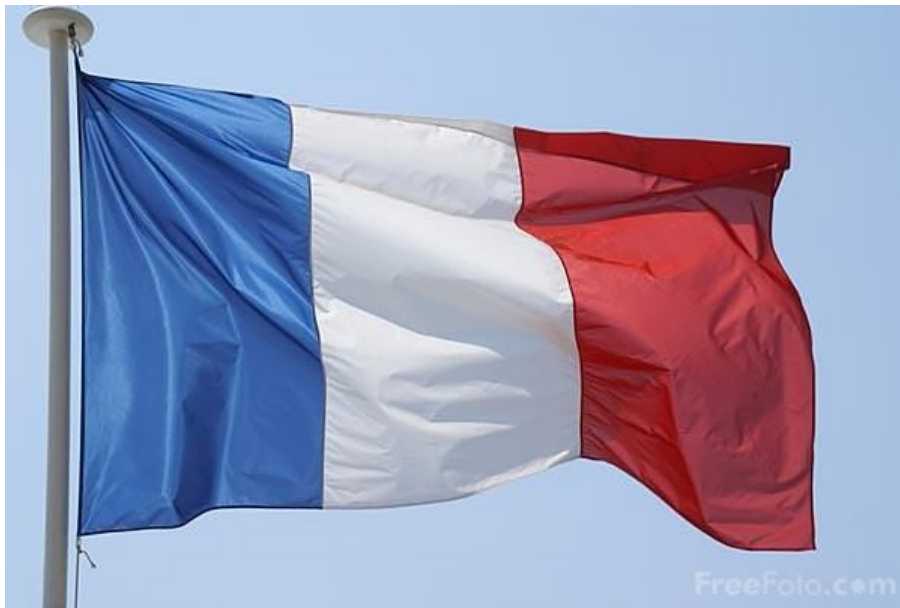
- Practice basic throwing and catching skills with different types and sized balls.
