




Class One Autumn 2

Here are some of the things the children we will be learning about in topic. Please note some of these activities may change depending on the children's learning needs.

History



We will be learning about the significant British monarchs in history, with a more in-depth study of Richard III as well as drawing comparisons between Elizabeth I and Queen Victoria. The children will


become aware of significant individuals through using timelines and making comparisons between various periods in history.

Art, Design and Technology



We will be creating a sculpture using different materials that are easily found in the local environment.

Physical Education



We will be looking at how we can develop our balancing skills including a look at Yoga.

Science




The children will learn about everyday materials including wood, plastic, metal, water and rock. They will learn to identify and name everyday materials and will have the opportunity to explore the properties of these materials. At the end the children will apply their knowledge of everyday materials to sort objects by their properties.

Religious Education



The children will learn about the importance of Christmas in the Christian calendar.

Homework



Homework: Remember to read, at least, 15 minutes a day. Your child should be reading Orange books fluently by the end of Year One. Spellings: These are given out on Friday ready for a test on the following Friday. These should be practised at home to aim for full marks. A quick reminder that the children will be taking the government's phonics assessment later in the year.
