Our Food



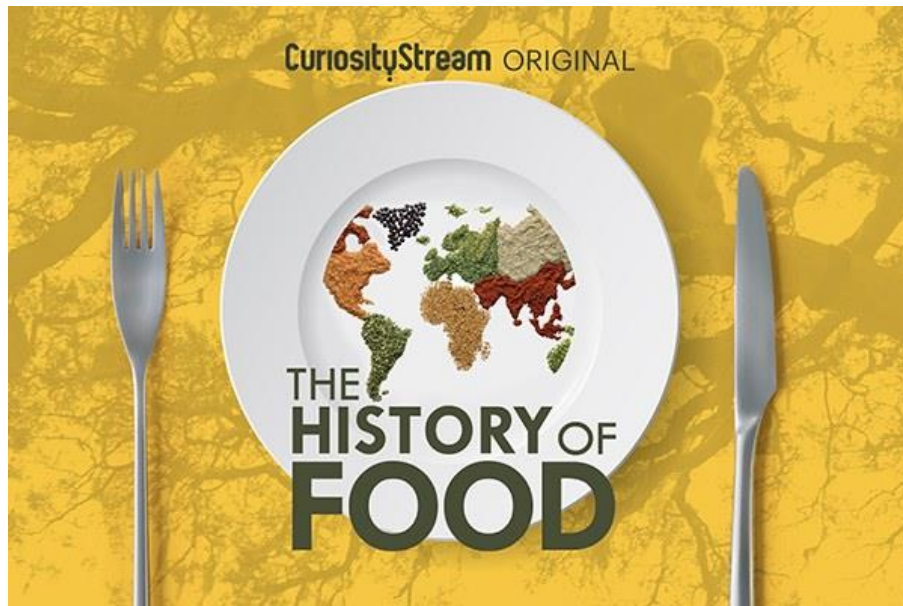
Our key subjects for this topic are: **History, geography and PSHE.**

In English we will be looking at Persuasive writing which we have some links to our topic.

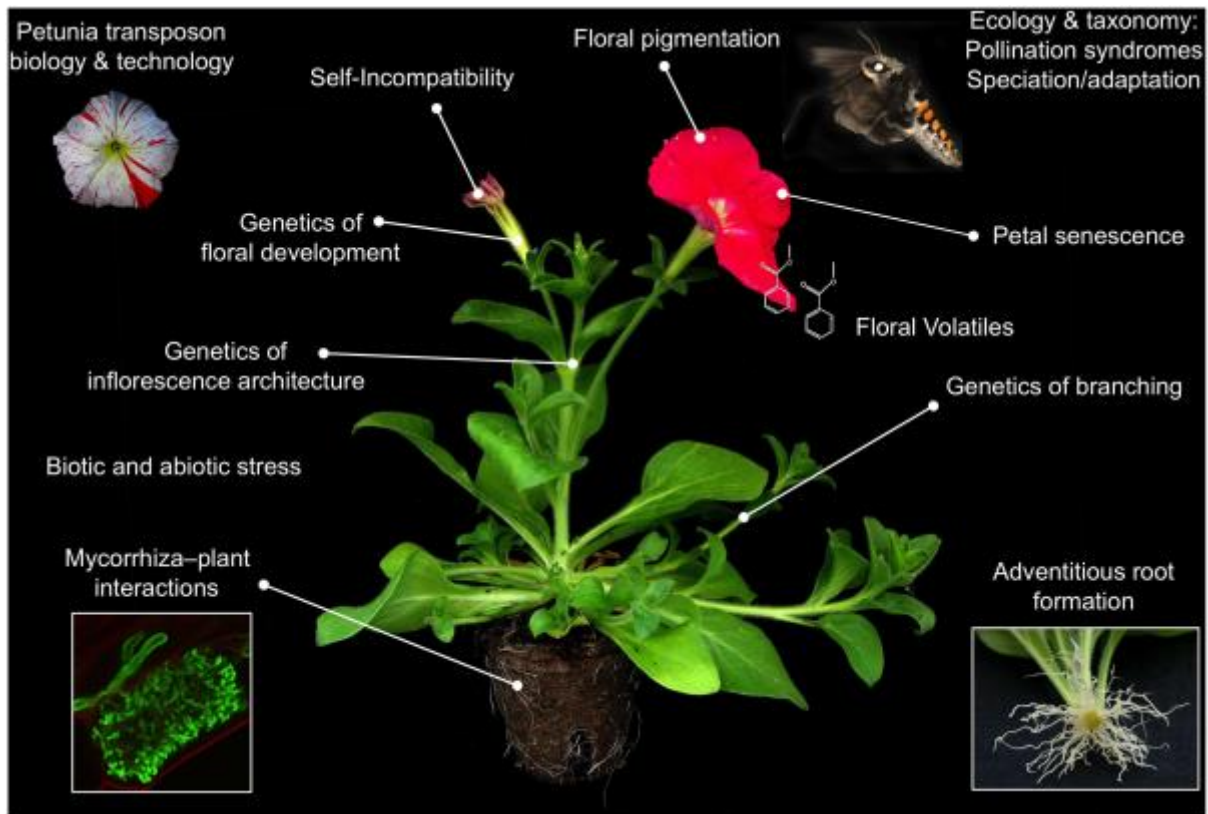
Humanities and PSHE - Food



During this half term we will be looking at:

- Where different food comes from and locating on a map
- What ingredients are in food - examining food labels
- Food waste - how much is wasted? Where does it go?
- Ecological impact of food
- What food is available to us locally?

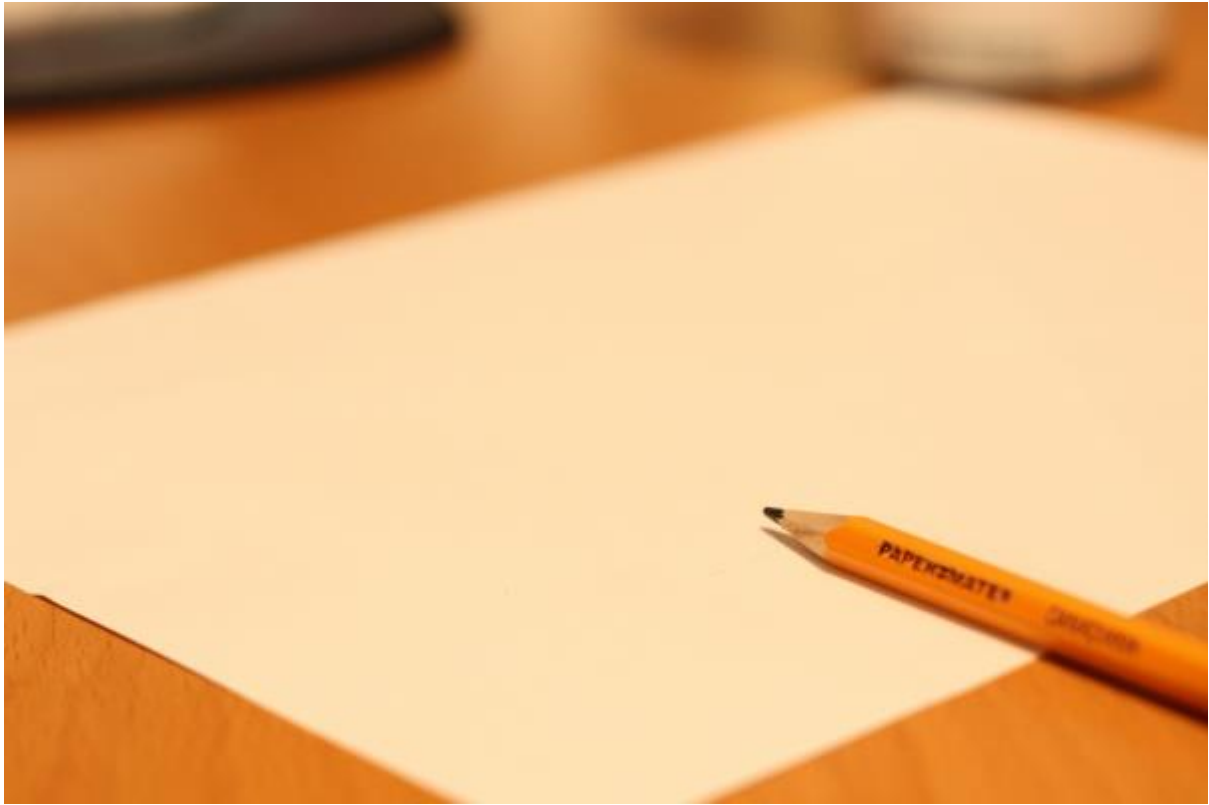
Science - Plants



During this half term we will be:

- identifying and describing different parts of a flowering plant
- exploring the requirements of plants for life
- investigating the way in which water is transported in plants
- exploring that part flowers play in the life cycle of flowering plants

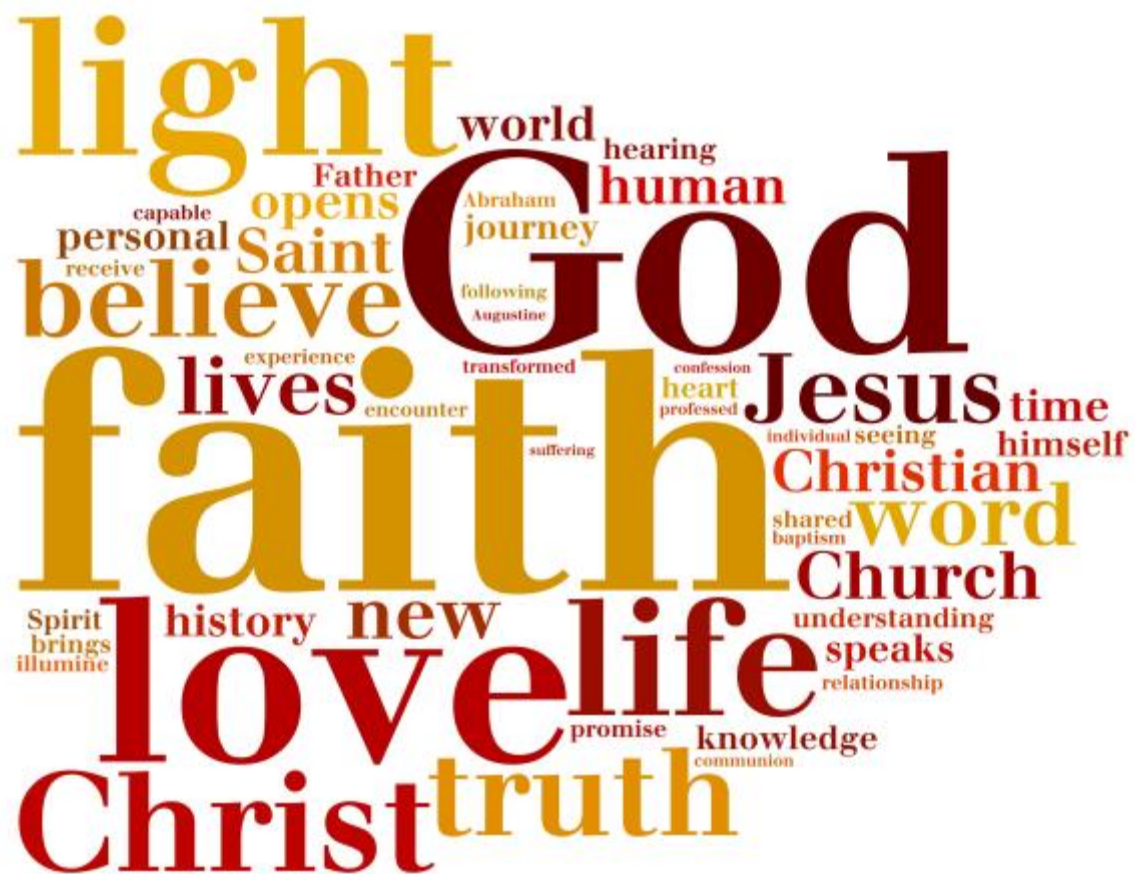
Art - pencil and drawing



During this half term we will be:

- examining examples of pencil drawings
- experimenting with pencils to create different lines
- looking at how we can create shade and texture
- recreate a fruit or vegetable with pencil skills

Religious Education - ethical & moral choices



During this half term we will be:

- looking at what good moral and ethics are
- looking at how we can make good choices
- discussing a selection of moral questions based on philosophy for children

Computing - coding & debugging

During this half term we will be:

- setting start conditions which could include using sensors later on
- using repeat and loop commands
- creating a code for a given purpose of to achieve a goal
- testing a code and debugging

PE - Batting and field games



Year 3 will be learning Non - stop rounders and will be looking at:

- learn practice correct throwing and catching techniques
- the rules of rounders
- practice and develop skills through play
- team communication and tactics

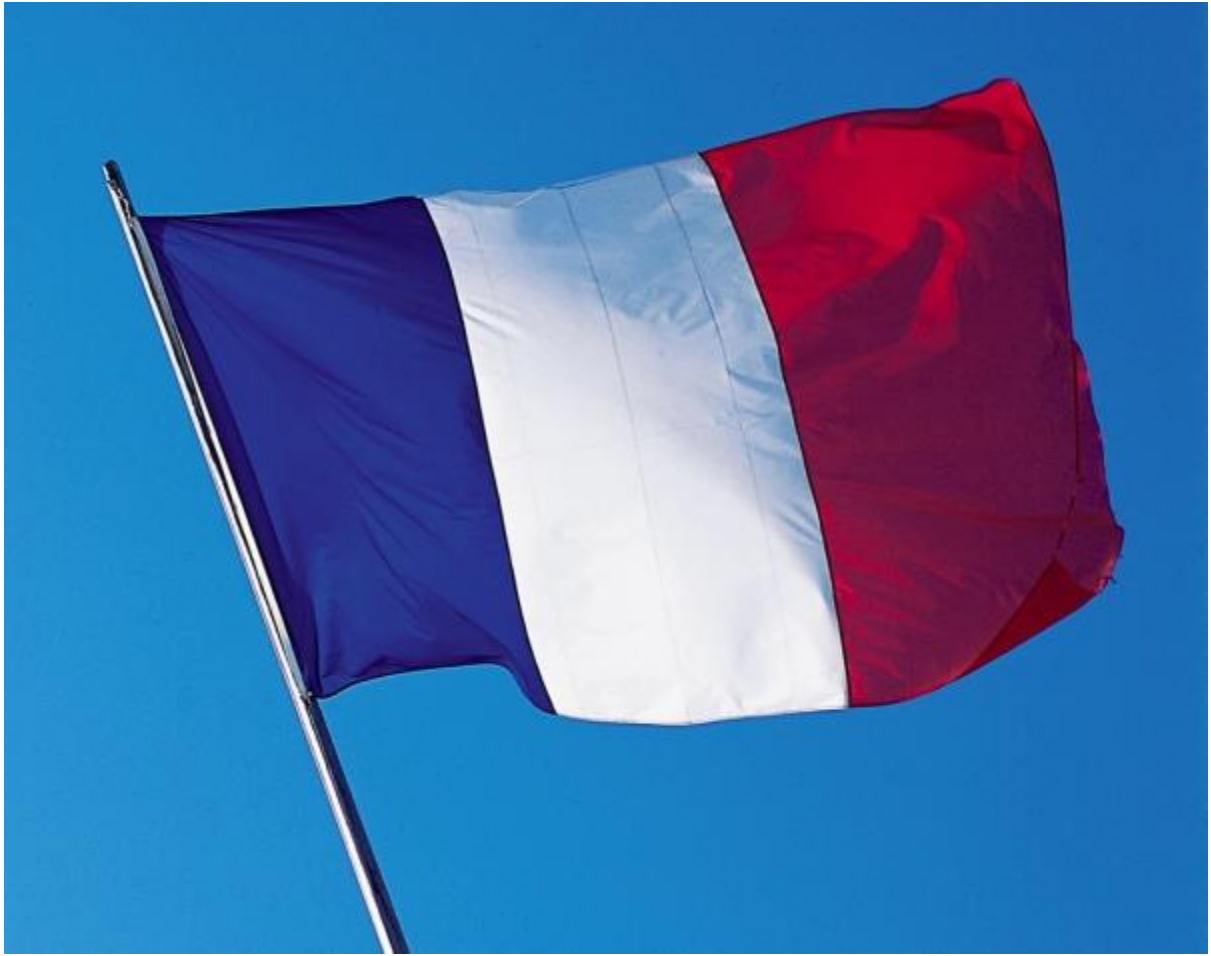
Music - History of 20th century music
