In literacy we will be linking our writing to our guided reading text "Firework Makers Daughter". We will write a narrative based on this text and a diary entry.

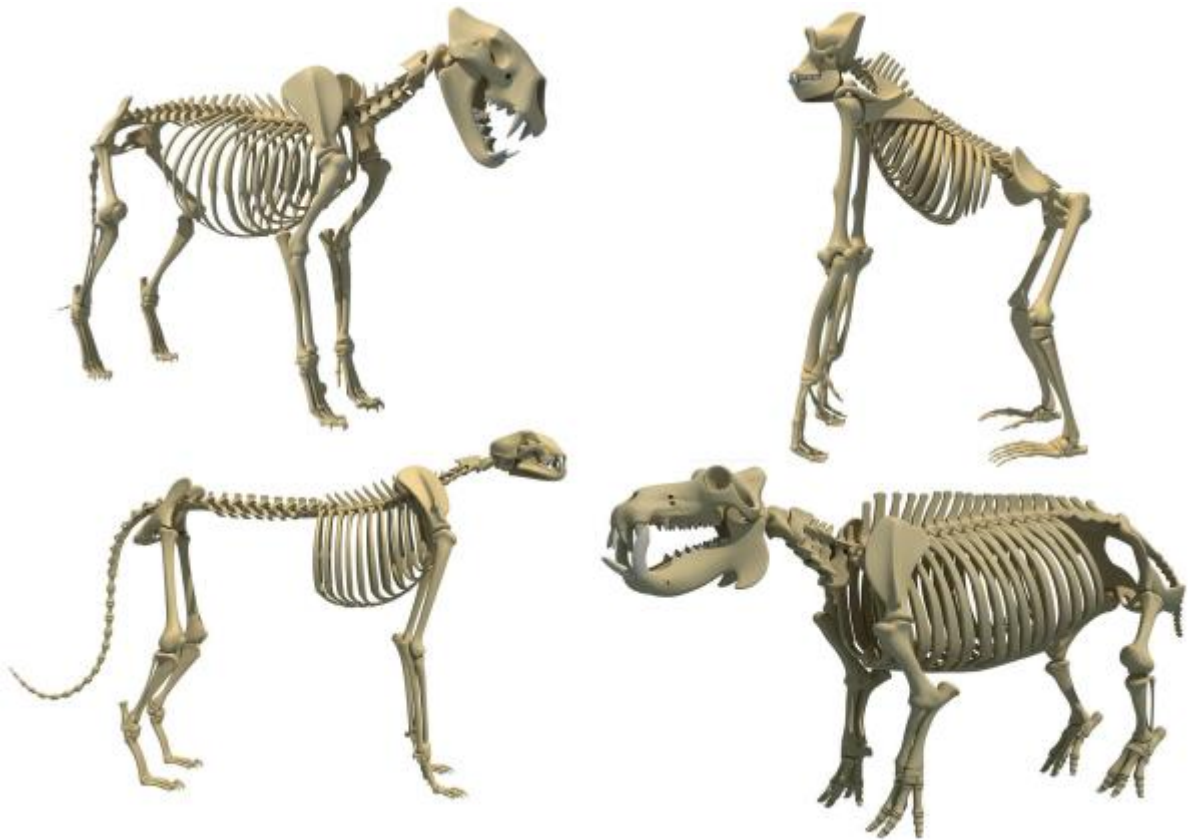
History - Stone Age



During this half term we will be looking at:

- Stone Age timeline
- The development of food and cooking
- Technology and inventions from stone age
- Homes and settlements
- Designing and rebuilding a replica of Stonehenge

Science - Animals including humans



During this half term we will:

- Construct and interpret food chains
- Identify animals need the right types of nutrition's to survive
- Identify why humans and some animals have skeletons
- Identify why humans and some animals have muscles

Music - recorder



During this half term we will:

- Learn a basic playing technique
- Read simple musical notes
- Play together using the first 3 notes

Religious Education - Christianity



- Know the beliefs of Christianity
- Understand that the UK is a multicultural country
- Know the when and why of Christian festivals

PE - Throwing and catching/ attack and defence



We will be learning how to play netball and will be looking at:

- the rules of netball
- learning and practicing throwing and catching techniques
- practicing and developing skills through play
- team communication and tactics

Art - Painting



During this topic children will:

- Mix shades of primary and secondary colours
- Paint with control and show difference in texture
- Learn methods of applying paint with brushes
- Learn vocabulary relating to shades

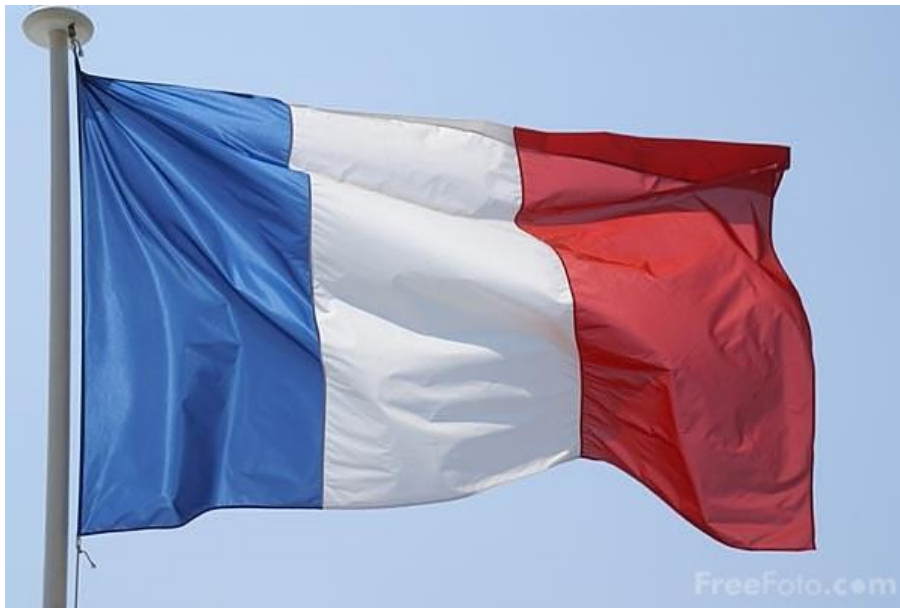
Internet Safety
